The Government of India (hereinafter called “Recipient”) has received grant from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), (the “Bank”) , acting as an implementing agency of the Global Environment Facility (GEF), (hereinafter called grant) toward the cost of Sustainable Livelihoods and Adaption to Climate Change Project (SLACC).

The Sustainable Livelihoods and Adaptation to Climate Change (SLACC) project (hereafter referred to as the project) is being implemented in Madhya Pradesh and Bihar under National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) of Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Government of India. The SLACC project has been implemented in about 200 villages covering 2 Districts each in Bihar and Madhya Pradesh.

In order to achieve the Project Development Objective (PDO) by improving adaptive capacity of rural poor engaged in farm-based livelihoods to cope with climate variability and change, consultancy is required to **develop and implement an M&E system** that establishes a project baseline and end of project evaluation against indicators mentioned in the Results Framework and the GEF Tracking Tool. The service provider is expected to use smart-phone technology and other appropriate technologies for data collection (geo tagged photos of sampled households for tracking), processing, analysis and presentation of results in a manner that is compatible for use with Geographical information system (GIS) to be developed through another consultancy. The period of consultancy is for 03 years.
